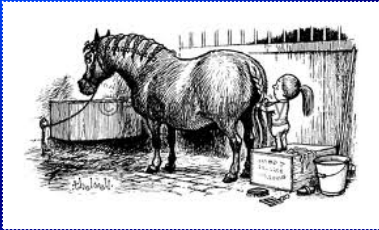


YOUNG PRODUCERS CLASS

This class will be divided according to entries. Please state on entry form the age of handler and whether horse/pony is Non-Native or Native Type..



METHOD OF JUDGING

This class is designed for young producers of the future. Entrants should not have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Entrants will be expected to prepare, produce and show their horse/pony in hand. This class will be divided into two sections but judged as one class – please state section entered on the entry form:

- Section A Juniors 16 years & under (age at 1 Jan in current year)
- Section B Juniors 17 – 25 years old

Marks will be awarded as follows:

1. Plaiting / Production 15 Marks
2. Production for breed / type 15 Marks
3. Turnout of horse / pony 15 Marks
4. Turnout of handler 15 Marks
5. Knowledge of Breed / Type 15 Marks
6. Showmanship in the Ring 15 Marks
7. Judges Choice 10 Marks



Judging will commence at 8am. Entrants may have one attendant to hold the horse / pony but may have no other outside help. The Judges will ask questions during the preparation process to test the knowledge of the entrant on breed / type and conformation defects.

Final presentation will take place during the 'Evening Performance' on Friday.

All entrants are to meet the Judges and Steward at 7.45 am in the lower grass ring in front of the stables. Horses / ponies are not to be plaited or prepared in any way prior to the start of judging.
